# Victorian and House Activities

#### **Historic House**

A tour of the historic interiors of Bowhill House can emphasise many aspects of Victorian life. An experienced and knowledgeable guide will showcase the trappings of the aristocracy and lifestyles of the wealthy, as well as room use and the development of technology such as central heating and gas lighting.

## Victorian Kitchen

Investigate the lives of servants in the 'engine room' of Victorian Bowhill. A closer look at food storage and preparation, as well as some familiar - and not so familiar - kitchen appliances and activities.

# **Portraits and Paintings**

Bowhill is the home of some of the most important art in private hands in Britain. What can we learn about life in the past from paintings? Can we read the 'messages' the artists have hidden in their work? Are these images real or imagined?

Ranger Activities

**Pond Dipping** 

A chance to learn about the ecosystem in and around the Bowhill Loch while offering the opportunity to develop identification, survey and recording skills. This session is easily adapted for various age groups and quickly enthuses most pupils.

#### **Woodland Plants & Trees**

This session looks at the woodlands of Bowhill, taking a closer look at plant and tree biology while learning about woodland ecology and management. Bowhill Estate illustrates a variety of woodland ecosystems along with hundreds of years of forest management. Easily tailored to suit any stage, this session can be very useful in re-enforcing and illustrating topics covered in class.

## **Team Building & Problem Solving**

Our team building days consist of team building games as an icebreaker, a team orienteering challenge to really bring the team together, followed by a problem solving exercise in the afternoon. A great chance to use the natural environment to bring pupils out of their shell and working together. Sessions can be tailored to suit the group abilities, interests and topics and are suitable for all age groups.

#### Costs

The cost for an educational visit to Bowhill, regardless of duration, is £3 per child plus VAT (in real terms £3.60 per child).

#### **Access Information**

Please let us know if any of your pupils have any access requirements. With the exception of one room, the entire House is accessible to wheelchair users. Our toilet facilities are also fully accessible. Some parts of the Estate are also wheelchair accessible, and most of our activities are carried out in wheelchair friendly spaces.
